### **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

1. Awards will be provided for a Junior Champion, Senior Champion and Grand Champion female of each Breed.
2. Junior And Intermediate Fitting and Showing Champions are ineligible for future competition in that age Division. However, they may compete in the next age division.
3. Senior and Grand Champion Fitting and Showing Champions are ineligible for future competition in the Senior Division, However, they may compete in the Sweepstakes Fitting and Showing.
4. All former Fitting and Showing Champions of 4-H and FFA are eligible to compete in the Sweepstakes Class. An individual must win the revolving sweepstakes bowl three (3)years in succession to retire the trophy.
5. First Year Fitting may show in their appropriate age class or novice class, but not both. .
6. All animals must be registered. If they are leased animals, they must be leased as of June 1, 2009 and registered in Exhibitor's Name, otherwise they must be registered in Exhibitor's name as of July 1, 2009.
9. At the discretion of Chairman, classes may be combined.
10. Herdsman award will be handled by department chairperson.
11. There will be an exhibitors meeting Tuesday night at 9:00 pm, for all 4-H dairy cow exhibitors. All must attend with at least one parent or guardian.
12. Only registered animals may be shown and they must be registered in the name of the Exhibitor. Registration papers will be checked.
13. All Livestock will be checked by State Veterinarian before unloading.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. Only registered animals may be shown and they must be registered in the name of the Exhibitor. Registration papers will be checked.
2. An entry fee of \$2.00 per head (non refundable) will be charged.
3. All animals must be on the grounds between 6am.-8am Saturday August 15 , 2009 .  
Open dairy animals may come in on Friday evening 6-8pm and must be checked by the vet.
4. All Livestock will be checked by State Veterinarian before unloading.
5. Breed Chairman have the authority to combine classes as necessary.
6. Animals must be shown as individuals in order to be eligible for group classes.
7. Each Exhibitor is limited to two (2) animals in any one class.
- 8.A "Prize" will be awarded to the "Supreme Champion" of all breeds.
