

## Department 602: Open Youth (8-21) Meat Goat Show

Any Youth ages 8- 21 years old - Meat Goat Show

General Rules and Regulations:

1. All animals must have a collar
2. All horned goats must be blunt tipped.
3. There is no limit to the number of animals entered and shown by any one exhibitor, but only two premiums will be paid per exhibitor per class.
4. No cross entering between market and breed classes.
5. All fitting and showing animals must be prepared by exhibitor.
6. Livestock show attire applies for showmanship classes.
7. Purebreed & Fullblood goats (ex. Boer, Kike, Spanish) must have registration papers issued in the name of the exhibitor by July 1, 2009 or they will be shown as crossbred/percentage.
8. Crossbreds must be tagged with commercial 4-H tags at June tagging. Copies of Livestock registration form (completed at tagging) must be presented at show check in.
9. Only those animals registered to be shown on official entry forms will be allowed on fair grounds.
10. Base date for aging animals is the show date. All bucklings must be born in the current year Except Senior Bucklings (Class #6).
11. A \$2.00 entry fee applies to all out of county 4-H/FFA members.
12. Out of county exhibitors must be prepared to show out of livestock trailers.

### **Market Class rules:**

- 1-Market goats must be less than one year old
- 2-Market goats will be shown by weight not breed. Chairman will weigh and divide classes into appropriate weight classes.
- 3-Weigh in time will be posted by chairman. Chairman and or 4-H educator/FFA adviser must be present at weigh in.
- 4-Live stock sale is for **Queen Anne's County 4-H Members only**. Queen Anne's County 4-H exhibitors may nominate one market goat for the livestock sale (see sale rules). Livestock sale rules apply for weights.
- 5-Only wether & doe kids may be shown in market classes. All wethers must be completely healed.

Dairy Goat- RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All animals must be provided a collar.
2. There will be no limit to the number of animals entered and shown by any one exhibitor, but only 2 premiums will be paid per exhibitor, per class.
3. All breed animals must have readable tattoos .
4. All 4-H Fitting and Showing animals must be prepared by the Exhibitor.
5. There will be no pre-show milk-out, unless otherwise stated.
- 6.. No Bucks allowed.
- 7..Only those animals registered to be shown on official entry forms will be allowed on the Fairgrounds.
8. Base date for aging animals is the show date.
9. Herdsman award to be handled by department chairpersons.
- 10.This doe show will NOT be ADGA sanctioned. 4-H/FFA rules shall govern.
- 11.All animals 6 months of age and older must have an original ADGA Registration Certificate.

12. All animals must have breed association registration papers by July 1, 2008 in the 4-H members name. Kids born after July 1, 2009 must have proof of ownership of the dam before July 1, 2009
13. No "Horned" animals of any kind will be allowed in dairy show.

## **Department 603: OPEN DAIRY GOAT SHOW**

### **Combined Junior/Senior Doe Show**

Judged: Monday August 10, 2009

9:00 A.M. – animals on grounds by 8am.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. The Combined Sr. & Jr. doe shows are sanctioned for the following breeds to be shown in this order: Alpine, AOP- (Oberhasli , Saanens, Lamancha, Sables), Nubians, Nigerian Dwarf, Recorded Grade, and Toggenburg. No horned animals allowed. The combined Sr & Jr. doe shows are not separately sanctioned.
2. Entry fees are \$3.00 per animal and must accompany the entry form. There will be no refund of entry fees for any reasons. No faxed entry forms allowed. Substitutions will be allowed within the same breed and show. There is no limit to the number of animals which can be shown by an exhibitor, but only 2 premiums will be paid per exhibitor per class. Additionally , in order to receive premiums and championship legs, all animals must have readable tattoos. Animals entered in showmanship classes must be entered in their breed classes.
3. PENS. A limited number of pens will be available on a first come, first serve basis at \$5.00 per pen. Queen Anne's County 4-H members are not required to pay pen fees, but must pay the entry fees. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed, water ,hay and bedding. **Exhibitors are required to clean their pens of bedding materials or will forfeit their premiums.**
4. The base date is August 10, 2009 which is the date the animal is to be judged.
5. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and must be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The original registration or duplicate application stamped by ADGA, or stamped Faxed duplicate application is required for all animals under six months of age and must be shown to the Show Secretary before the show. No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped duplicate application , telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
6. Animals must be on the grounds and checked in by 8a.m. Judging will begin at 9 a.m. All animals must be provided with a collar.
7. The show committee, QA County Fair Board, Queen Anne's County 4-H park, and the ADGA, will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person, animal or property.
